- Please be reminded that this workshop is for teachers, and although we understand that your children love the zoo and aquarium, they can not attend the workshop with you.
- Please download the Bronx Zoo directions and classroom map document so that you know how to find your classroom on the first day of class. The zoo is a big place, so make sure that you have your classroom map and that you know your classroom. If you get lost in the zoo (which almost all of our course participants do), ask someone for help. Most staff will be able to direct you to the exhibits the classrooms are located in. If your workshop is at the Aquarium, Central Park Zoo, Queens Zoo, or Prospect Park Zoo, you should make sure to have the directions and maps that were sent to you or look on the facility websites for more information.
- Keep in mind that the zoos and aquarium do not open until 10:00 am and the gates we specify are the only gates that will be open.
- Please make sure to bring the appropriate payment for the class you are attending (see workshop description for details).
- Please bring your own lunch.
- Dress comfortably. We will be doing a lot of walking and will spend time outside regardless of weather. So come prepared!
- Bring your camera, because you never know what you will see at the zoo!
- Come prepared to participate and share your ideas and experiences with other teachers.
- You should bring this document as proof of admittance to get into the park.
